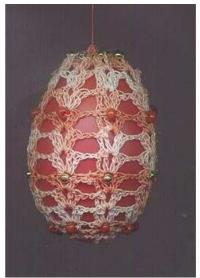


Nuncia

Easter Egg Cover





instruction below is without beads - picture on the right is a variation with beads

Egg Size:app. 6 to 7 cm (2.6") pastic egg

Material:rest of thread you like 100% cotton yarn

for decoration: ribbon

hook 1.25 mm (US steel 10)

Abbreviations and Terms

ch...chain stitch sc...single crochet sl st...slip stitch st(s)...stitch(es) hdc...half double crochet dc...double crochet

INSTRUCTIONS:

don't forget to put egg in on time join every round with slst

Beginning: 7 ch, join ring with slst

Round 1: 2 ch, 11 hdc in ring

Round 2: 3 ch, 1 hdc in next st, (1 hdc, 1 ch, 1 hdc) across

Round 3: slst in 1 ch-chain, (3 ch, 1 ch, 2 dc) in same 1 ch-chain, (2 dc, 1 ch, 2 dc) = (shell) in every 1 ch-chain across

Round 4: 1 slst in 1. 1 ch-chain, 3 ch, 2 ch, 2 dc in next 1 ch-chain, (2 dc, 2 ch, 2 dc) in every 1 ch-chain across

Round 5: slst in 2 ch-chain, (3 ch, 2 ch, 2 dc) in 2 ch-chain, 2 ch, *2 dc, 2 ch, 2 dc in 2 ch-chain, 2 ch* repeat from * to * across

Round 6: slst in 2 ch-chain, (3 ch, 3 ch, 2 dc) in 2 ch-chain, 3 ch, *2 dc, 2 ch, 2 dc in 2 ch-chain, 3 ch* repeat from * to * across

Round 7 and 8: = Round 6

Round 9: = Round 5

Round 10: slst in 2 ch-chain, (3 ch, 2 ch, 2 dc) in 2 ch-chain, 1 ch, *2 dc, 2 ch, 2 dc in 2 ch-chain, 1 ch* repeat from * to * across

Round 11: slst in 1 ch-chain, (3 ch, 1 ch, 2 dc) in 2 ch-chain *2 dc, 2 ch, 2 dc in 2 ch-chain* repeat from * to * across

Round 12: join thread through next three shells, and draw through all 4 loops, repeat across

Fasten off

put on decoration like picture shows

variation: if you use beads don't forget to put them on thread first.
